Mays singled in second inning for 3,000th hit of his major league career and added another single in sixth to provide historical significance to Giants' 10-1 victory over Expos. Mays walked in first inning when Giants scored five runs. After Willie's single in second, game was stopped briefly for congratulatory ceremonies in which Hall of Famer Stan Musial, also member of 3,000-Hit Club, participated. When game resumed, Mays took place on base and scored on double by McCovey. Giants' super star drove in run with his second single in sixth before leaving game. Perry, who pitched four-hitter to beat Expos, joined in Giants' attack with homer and double. Perry also tied major league fielding record for pitchers with five putouts in game.
